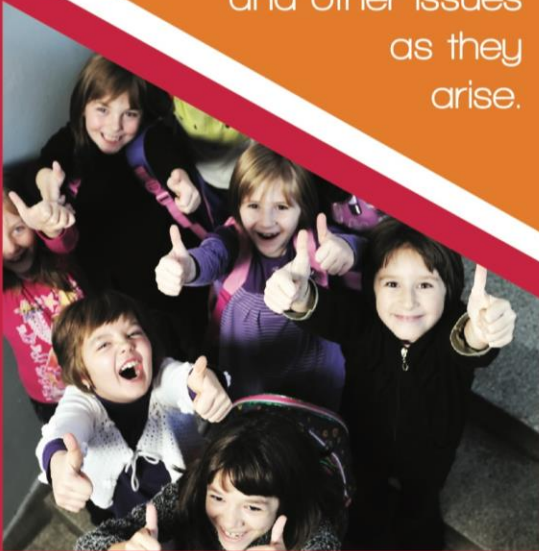

EYP Programme promotes the empowerment, participation and active citizenship of young unemployed people and NEET's in particular. This programme ensures the development of life skills and knowledge necessary to overcome barriers to participation, while actively involving local businesses and stakeholders.

The EYP PROGRAM offers practical instruction on:

- 1- How to engage local stakeholders; making them aware of the level of responsibility the programme requires and ensuring they know how they can get involved. .
- 2- How to engage NEET's and run the programme effectively while helping to foster young people's skills and abilities to facilitate their social and work interactions.
- 3- How to involve the community and local businesses in the young people's development and inclusion process, to increase the chance of employment.

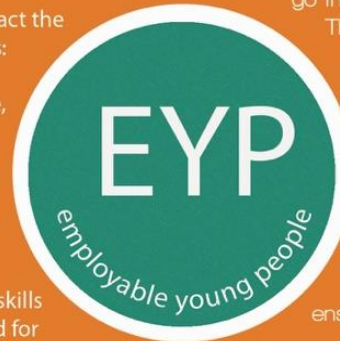
ABOUT EYP PROGRAM

The programme offers a new way to deliver young people into work and supporting NEET'S personal development, while actively engaging territorial stakeholders and local businesses in the process. Allowing the NEET's to be supported within work and social situations.

The Innovative way the programme facilitates the collaboration between local communities, young people, businesses and local establishments that provide support for young people, is by increasing their awareness and their responsibility for the creation of a better support system.

The programme is expected to impact the young people in the following ways:

1. Improved motivation, confidence, self- esteem and attitude toward social interactions and being a part of the work force
2. More active participation in daily life within society
3. Increased cultural awareness
4. Improved soft and interpersonal skills necessary for today's work force and for integration into society.



The 4 phases that make up the programme are:

1. Activate a stable network to improve the community's ability to include young people into daily social life. Young participants will go through a personal development program. This will help to increase the participant's communication abilities, motivation, self-esteem and attitude towards society.
2. Local enterprises and businesses are asked to assess their long term commitment to the integration of the young people into work. The skills and competencies of the young participant are measured to ensure they are given the right personalised development plan.
3. The young participants are prepared to face interviews and to enter a structured work environment. Suggestions will be made to improve the of job openings within the community.
4. Based on improvements suggested the young participants will then be integrated into training courses. Companies are then encouraged to offer mentoring and job shadowing opportunities.
