- Participants should understand the job application process.

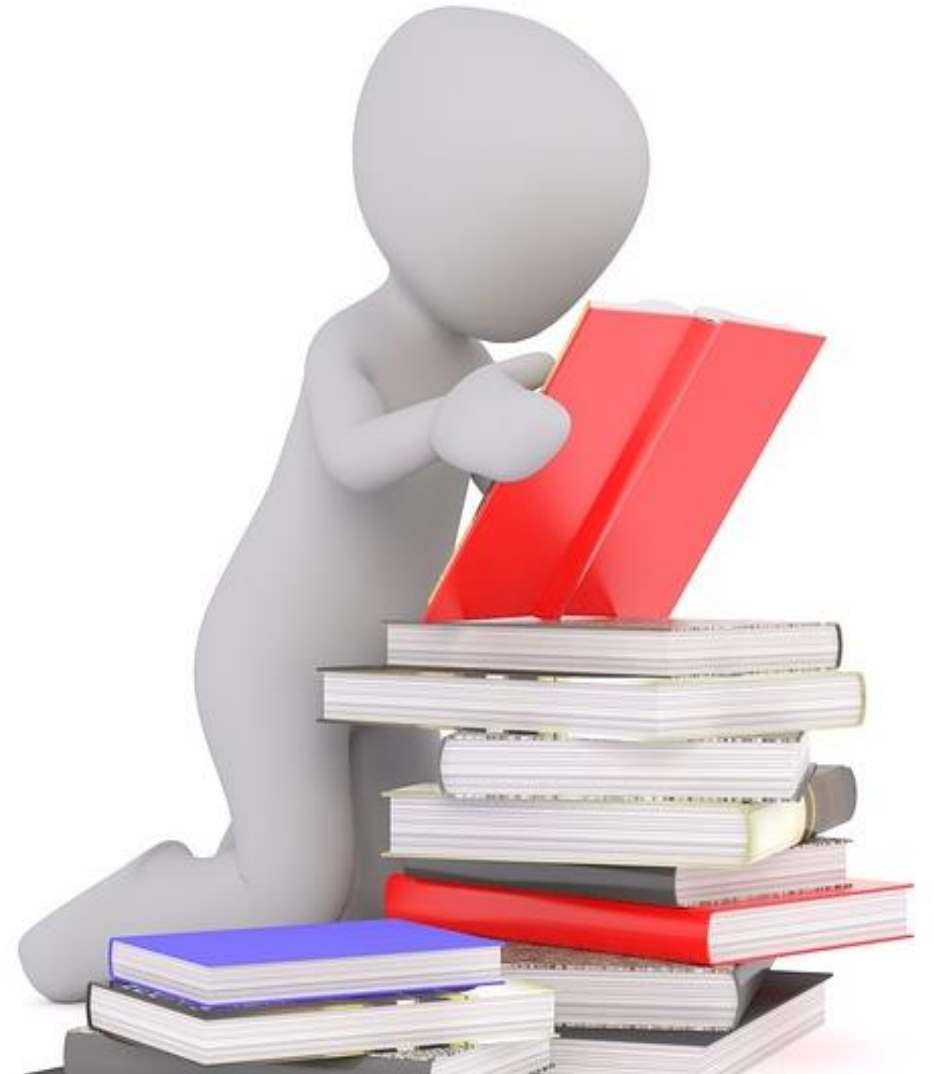
Skills Connected
